Visit to the Child of Prague

I was invited to join a group of 20 on a 4-day trip to Prague. On the morning of departure, we were taken by minibus at 4am to Manchester for a 6.40 am flight. Arriving at Terminal 3 we discovered that one of the suitcases was left behind, 'everyone worst nightmare'. After the initial shock and recriminations, with telephone calls going back and forward, the suitcase was found and was speeding its way by taxi to the airport. The owner of the suitcase and her companion stayed behind with a 'I'll catch you up' while the rest of us booked ourselves in. With all the confusion about the missing suitcase and the time wasted, I made a fatal mistake by going with a member of the group for a cup of tea and, not realising the time, missed the flight by three minutes. So, there we stood with a look of disbelief on our faces when two more of the group came tearing down the corridor towards the gate. No amount of pleading would persuade the attendant to let us board. I don't know if you ever missed a flight but boy, what a horrible feeling..... I was so looking forward to going to Prague. As we were going through the process of reclaiming our suitcases and planning our trip back home, out through the exit door appeared one of the two ladies who had stayed behind for meet the taxi with the missing suitcase. "We missed the flight too". But don't give up she said, EasyJet has a flight to Prague this evening from terminal 1 at 7.15 pm but it means a new one-way ticket!! 'Oh, let's do it' we cried in unison.

We eventually arrived at our hotel in Prague just after 10 pm local time. The other members of our party were there to welcome us to the Hotel William. I fell into bed that night with exhaustion!

The following morning, we had a breakfast to die for, full English, baskets of different breads, cakes, tea, coffee, hot chocolate if you are into that in the morning, juices, cereal etc..... enough to set you up for the day.

Mass at the church of Our Lady of Victory where the statue of the child of Prague is enshrined was just ten minutes from the hotel. The custodian of the church invited the group into the sacristy after Mass for a special blessing of the statue of the Child of Prague. (I have plenty of the prayer cards if anyone would like one!) We then had a guided tour around the old city; the famous clock in the main square, crossing the Charles bridge, a tram ride up to the castle. The city was alive with music and the great weather only added to the visit.

Apart from the disappointments of those first few hours on day one our trip to Prague was a wonderful experience.
