Activity Hub

The activity hub is aimed at giving children a safe and caring environment, whilst developing and learning new skills, socialising, and relaxing after a challenging day at education. Parents will have the reassurance of knowing their children are enjoying their activities in a safe and positive environment.

Speak to your family support worker about funding.



Zone 1 – will be a social space to relax, talk to friends, YP will be able to bring their own electronics Le., switch, IPad, phones etc. This space will also have timetabled Movie, pool, table football time etc.

Zone 2 - Craft room, YP will be able to use the craft room for a multitude of crafts ranging from Jewellery making, painting, drawing, paper quilling, papermaking, soap, and candle making etc. Zone 3 – many board games will be available throughout the session.

> Zone 4 — Kitchen will be available for bookable slots for cooking skills.
