Year 1 Autumn Term 1 – Unity in the Community



Main Texts

The Bog Baby by Jeanne Willis

Maths

We start the year working with numbers and place value up to 10 then move onto numbers up to 20. Children will be practising simple addition and subtraction calculations. We will also focus on geometry looking at position and direction.

Science

In our Science lessons we will have fun learning outside the classroom in the forest to name and talk about different plants and trees. We will be recognising and labelling different parts of a plant. Also, we will be learning about seasonal changes and talking about the different seasons and the changes that occur. Year 1 will be investigating questions including 'How can we sort the leaves that we collected on our walk?' by identifying and classifying.

Vocabulary: Daffodils, daisy, oak tree, birch tree, roots, stem, flower, petals, seasons, Autumn, Spring, Summer, Winter





Come and See

Within our first topic 'Families', children will be learning about God's love and care for every family. Children will be able to recognise the stories and psalms which reveal God's love and care and creating a prayer about God's love for us. In our Baptism topic we will be learning about belonging to different groups as well as a Baptism; an invitation to belong to God's family. Vocabulary:

Family, belong, God, love, care, different, God's children, psalm, family of God, response, Baptism, Holy water, God's family.

English

Our focus text this half term that we will be reading is 'The Bog Baby' by Jeanne Willis. We will be using lots of descriptive language to describe the Bog Baby as well as describing the Pond then compose sentences using these descriptive words. We will be creating our own posters, writing a letter to the Bog Baby as well as re-telling and writing key parts of the story. We will continue to develop sentence structure and practise using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing.

Within Phonics we will be learning new sounds each day and practising to read and write words with these new sounds, as well as practising to read and write some high frequency and tricky words.
