In last week's newsletter, I mentioned Jan and I had made a number of pilgrimages to Lourdes. The combined number of miles, both there and returning, must total a few thousand! We have enjoyed travelling together in the nearly 40 years we have known one another, mostly holidays, with several pilgrimages as well.

In 1982, shortly after Pope John Paul II had visited Britain, I travelled to Italy with the Liverpool Youth. This was several years before Jan and I met. During this time, the group visited a place that had such an impact on me! It was not majestic, like St Petersburg; nor magnetic, such as Jerusalem. This place was characterised by its simplicity, challenge and holiness. This place was Assisi!

I had wanted Jan to visit Assisi, and to experience why I thought there could not be a lovelier place. Thankfully, we have visited Assisi twice together. But the year before we first went to Assisi, we discovered the beautiful town of Avila, a place so much associated with St Teresa. I find it difficult to convey how these places have affected me.

Maybe, you just need to be there, and to open your heart and mind to their beauty and simplicity - visual, spiritual and material.

Both Assisi and Avila have their religious heroes; both Francis and Teresa wanted to draw people closer to Jesus.
