Three Giant Steps.

Three Giant Steps is a thematic unit based around three contrasting locations, with a key focus on Geography. We will continue to develop our sense of place in the world by studying three focus places. We will identify the position of all three places in the world along with climate, capital city, time zone population and area. We will also learn about the human and physical geography of each place.

May the Force be with You.

"May the Force be with You" is a thematic unit based around magnets and forces, with a key focus on science. We will begin by learning about contact and noncontact forces, before focusing on magnets. We will learn about magnetic forces, the relevance of magnetic North and South poles and the concept of magnetic attraction and repulsion.

Lindow Man

Lindow Man is a thematic unit with a history focus, telling the story of prehistoric Britain, from the Stone Age to the Celts. Pupils will learn all about their achievements and ongoing legacy.

Lindow Man was discovered in 1984 in Cheshire (not far from Widnes).

Jurassic Hunter

Jurassic Hunter is a history-based theme, with a focus on the four competencies of courage, commitment, creativity and community, integrating the subjects of art, science, English and geography. The children will hear all about the story of Mary Anning the world's most famous female palaeontologist which is both challenging and inspirational.
