Dear Parents/Carers

Children from Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are working in class with the staff from their year group. They will complete the work set by their teacher just as the children who are working safely at home will do. They will have lunch in the hall in their bubble and play in a zone for each year group on the Infant playground.

## **Key Stage 2 children**

Children in Year 3,4,5, and 6 are working in the hall together supervised by teachers and support staff. Support in school will be using the home learning that the rest of the children from our school will be accessing safely from home. It will be exactly the same therefore as sometimes the children will need to 'listen' to their teacher online we would ask that your child, if possible, brings in earphones from home with them each time they are in school. School does have a limited number of earphones but for safety during Covid it would be better if they have their own and they bring and use them in school.

Staff will be wearing masks in the hall to keep your child as safe as possible and if you wish to, your child can bring their own mask in to wear too.

School lunch will usually be a hot meal; the revised menu is attached.

It is imperative that you inform school as early as possible if your child will be absent and was expected to attend, together with the reason, as this needs to be recorded by the office staff for the Department of Education.

Finally, in order for us all to keep each other safe I must stress the importance of keeping your child **at home** if they are displaying any of the COVID-19 symptoms or if a member of your family has tested positive or is waiting for their test result.
