The Ascension of the Lord – Holy Day of Obligation

The **Feast of the Ascension of the Lord** commemorates that Jesus Christ physically ascended into Heaven in the presence of his apostles. It marks the end of his visible earthly mission and his exaltation as Lord, seated at the "right hand of God". We celebrate this feast on **Thursday 14th May**. As ever, we shall celebrate this feast, worthily and wisely.

Wednesday 13th May at 7pm at St. Basil's RC Church – 1st Sung Vespers of the Ascension. Sung Vespers of the Ascension is a solemn evening prayer service—part of the Liturgy of the Hours—that celebrates the glorification of Jesus as he returns to the Father. While "Vespers" refers to the general evening office, a "**Sung**" Vespers indicates that the majority of the service, including the psalms, hymns, and antiphons, is chanted or performed by a cantor and the congregation rather than spoken.
