# PARENT PROTOCOL Children returning – 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2020

Drop off/Pick up times:

- Children must be dropped off by one parent/carer only and leave the school grounds as soon as your child/children have been dropped off.
- Please inform us if your child in Year 6 will be walking home on their own or will be picked up.

# Children will enter /exit at the following points:

- Reception use the entrance on the infant playground and enter class through the Reception wooden gate.
- Year 1- use the entrance on the Infant playground
- Year 6- use the Yr5/Yr6 doors
- Key workers Bubble- Year 3/4 entrance on the Junior playground.
- There will be staggered times to pick up and drop off your child/children, if you have children in two different year groups please drop off/ pick up according to the earlier time.
- Reception Bubble: 9.00am /2.30pm
- Year 1 Bubble: 8.50am /2.45pm
- Year 6 Bubble: 8.40am / 3.00pm
- Key workers Bubble 8.30am/3.10pm

# For everybody's safety it is imperative that parents are punctual!

# What should my child wear?

- Your child will need to wear their school uniform
- A clean washed PE kit which will remain in school
- All clothing must be clearly named. We have been advised that all items of clothing should be washed at home at the end of each school day.

# What should my child bring?

• Bring a morning snack and a disposable water bottle

- Packed lunches must be in a disposal bag to reduce cross contamination between home and school
- No other bags will be needed in school
- At this stage of reopening we will not be sending reading books home. This will be under constant review. These measures are in place to control the amount of possessions coming into and out of school, again, aimed at controlling the spread of the virus.

## Lunch Arrangements

- Children will eat in their own room at their designated space.
- Hot meals will not be provided.
- Children who are in receipt of universal infant free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch.
- Children who are in receipt of free school meals will continue to receive vouchers and parents will need to provide their child with a packed lunch.
- Children MUST NOT share food with others. Parents to remind their child about this regularly.

These are really difficult times and the safety of our school re-opening depends on the measures we are putting in place, but also your support for these required measures and your child understanding and following every new, but extremely important, expectations around social distancing / behaviour - it all forms part of our Risk Assessment. A Covid-19 Addendum to our Behaviour Policy has been added to our school website and can be located under the **Covid 19 information section**.

Please ensure that you discuss all of these changes with your child before they return to school on the 8<sup>th</sup> June. This will minimise any anxiety for them and ensure that staff can keep themselves and your child as safe as possible at all times.
