Maths

As SATs are over, we will continue our learning with some fun maths games and open-ended problems as well as a maths project centred on building a theme park. We will be applying our knowledge of all the maths we have learnt to solve problems and make decisions as a team in order to create the best theme park we can. We will use budgeting, loans and other real world financial ideas to work out our profits and revenues.



Science

In our science topic we will be looking at how materials change and which of those changes are reversible. We will look at dissolving, evaporation, decanting and filtering and discuss how these are applied in everyday situations.

Vocabulary:

Thermal/electrical insulator/conductor, change of state, mixture, dissolve, solution, soluble, insoluble, filter, sieve reversible/non-reversible change, burning, rusting, new material.



Come and See

In the topic Healing, we will learn about the sacrament of the sick and explore the scripture linked to it.

In our topic on Common Good children will develop their understanding of the human person made in the image of God and that we are part of God's global family, looking at how we can be fairer with people around the world, in terms of trade. In our other faiths topic, we will learn about Hinduism.

Vocabulary: Care, sickness, hospice, compassion, Sacrament, anointing, sin, forgiveness, parable, Lourdes, responsibility. Justice, injustice, respect, solidarity, difference, Social Justice, common good, dignity, Catholic Social Teaching. Karma, duty, salvation, Dharma, Moksha, aum.

English

Children will write their own explanation texts using all the correct features and selecting grammar and vocabulary for effect. Children will then look at letter writing and the features of letter writing again they will use these features to produce formal letters. The children will incorporate spelling, grammar and punctuation rules into their writing.

They will learn and write poetry for our Leaver's Assembly showing intonation, tone, and volume so that the meaning is clear to the audience.

We are still ensuring that we use our very best handwriting, and we are using 'Letter join' at home to help us to improve our handwriting further.

Throughout this half term the children will be working on the end of year school play. This enables children to participate in discussions, presentations, performances, role play and improvisations.
