# Made in God's image

You may recall that in last week's newsletter I made reference to the Season of Creation which runs from 1st September until the 4<sup>th</sup> October, the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi. In this Season of Creation, you may wish to read and reflect on the Story of Creation in Genesis 1. It's a wonderful story of how God brought order out of chaos.

For Catholics, rather than being a literal explanation for the origin of life, Genesis 1 teaches us key information about God's nature. God made the world how he wanted it to be, and he is omnipotent. Creation also highlights God's transcendence.

Here are a couple of extracts from Genesis 1 I'd like you to consider:

In the beginning, when God created the heavens and the earth....

and

Then God said: Let us make human beings in our image, after our likeness.

From these texts we see that each one of us is part of God's beautiful creation. Because of this we understand that every human life is equal, inherently sacred and worthy of dignity and respect. This is not some kind of tame, abstract and purely conceptual understanding. It is active. It's a call to us to create communities and social systems that reflect the underlying love and divinity of each person.

A parish is not complete or whole unless it includes, nurtures, and rejoices in each of its members, for each of its diverse members are made in God's image.

Jesus welcomed everyone. Let's follow His example and continue to open our doors and our hearts wider.
