Go with the Flow

"Go with the Flow" is a thematic unit based around life processes, with a key focus on science. We begin by looking at the changes that take place as humans develop to old age, recognising the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function. We will also learn about the human circulatory system and the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. Finally, we will learn about the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

The Rescuers

"The Rescuers" is a thematic unit with a history focus, telling the inspirational stories of two of the lesser-known heroes of the Titanic - Molly Brown and Harold Bride. We will learn, through their life stories, about their courage and ongoing legacies.

Pupil Voice Project

Our third enrichment unit will be a pupilled unit based on current affairs. We will look at a recent event or story from around the world and allow the children to lead the activities.

This time of year is always very busy as we build up to SATs, so we will also be completing our revision and preparation for the tests.

Time Team

This unit involves the pupils identifying and choosing a famous person from the past who lived in their area. They will then focus on key landmarks in their local village, town or city, undertaking research to find out important information about each one. Once the research has been completed, the pupils will be asked to put together their very own walking tour of their village, town or city which they will host for the chosen famous person from the past (an adult in role).
