Logical connectives

These should include:

Therefore Moreover Furthermore

Notwithstanding the fact that......

Emotional language

Persuade the reader with emotional language. For example:

All my friends can watch it....

Everyone will laugh at me...

Conditional sentences

Try to use a conditional sentence to support your argument.

If I can stay up tonight I will clean my room....

Rhetorical questions

Use rhetorical questions to persuade your audience:

How much longer will you treat me like a child when I am in year 6?

Use good reasons


Think of good reasons for your point of view.
