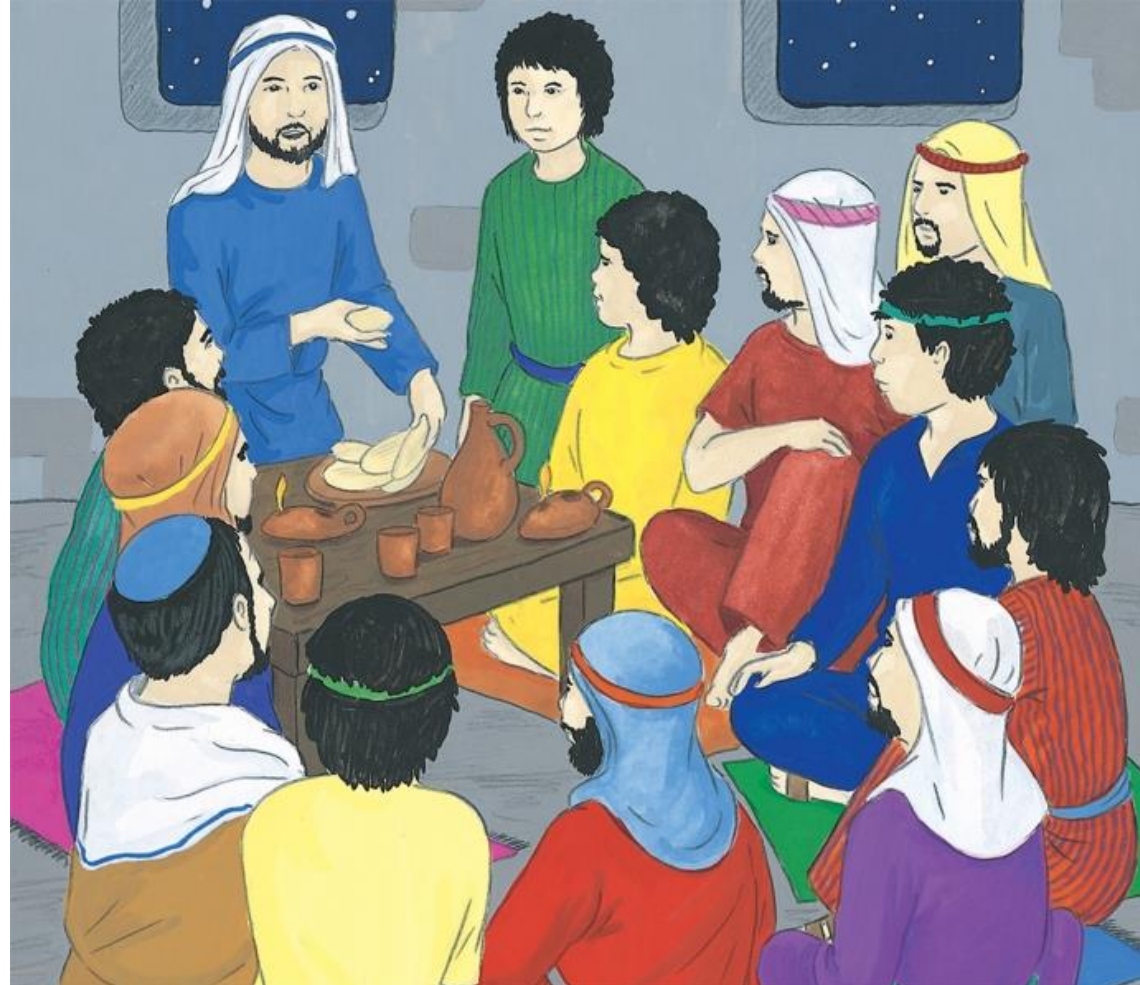


The Last Supper

Show the picture of Jesus having a special meal with his friends. Discuss the picture and then read the story on the next page.





The night before he died, Jesus and his friends went to Jerusalem to celebrate a special meal together.

While they were at table, Jesus took some bread, gave thanks to God, broke it and gave it out to his friends.

He said, "Take and eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in memory of me."

In the same way, Jesus took a cup of wine. He gave thanks, and gave it to them saying, "Take and drink. This is my blood shed for you."

Based on Luke 22: 19-20
(Come and See)

This is why, ever since then, Jesus' friends have met together to celebrate the Eucharist in thanksgiving as they remember him and do again what he told them to do.

Another name for the celebration of the Eucharist is Mass.

Key Questions

- What do we call this special meal?
- Who did Jesus give thanks to?
- What did Jesus do?
- What did Jesus say about the bread and wine?
- What did Jesus ask his friends to do?
- How do you think the friends of Jesus felt?

Activity

- Role-play the story of the Last Supper. Freeze frame at various points and describe the actions and recall the words Jesus said.
