



CURRICULUM OVERVIEW 2018-2019

YEAR 1 ~ SUMMER 2nd HALF TERM

Come and See

The first topic we will be learning about in Come and See is 'Being Sorry'. We will talk about making choices and how we know whether our choices are right or wrong. We will also recognise times we have said sorry and we will ask questions about forgiveness.

The second topic we will be covering is 'Hinduism'. We will listen to different Hindu stories such as 'The story of Ganesh'. We will write a retell about the story and also act it out. We will also look at Rahki bracelets and their symbolism.

English

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar – within our Phonics lessons we will practise spelling words with known sounds and we will also learn how to spell 'tricky words'. As well we will begin to think about how to write sentences independently: 'Say it; repeat it; write it; read it; check and full stop it.'

Instructions

Children will learn about why we use instructions. They will complete a 'shared write' set of instructions and then write their own instructions, 'How to look after a Plant' and 'How to keep our bodies healthy'.

Recount

The children will write a recount about Sports Day and also about their end of Year trip.

Children will:

- ☐ Become more familiar with using a keyboard to type simple sentences.
- ☐ Use a search engine such as 'Google' to search for images and save images into a folder.
- ☐ Create a power-point about 'animals in the Rainforest'.

Learning Challenge

Geography and Science

Children will:

- ☐ Learn about where the Amazon Rainforest is located on a map.
- ☐ Research what the weather is like in the Amazon Rainforest.
- ☐ Compare Widnes and the Amazon Rainforest and write about how Widnes and the Amazon Rainforest are different.
- ☐ Learn about plants that grow in the Rainforest.
- ☐ Discuss how to look after a plant by identifying what a plant needs to grow.

Creative Arts

Children will:

- ☐ Use warm and cold colours to create a collage and a painting of Animals that live in the Amazon Rainforest.
- ☐ Music – children will use background nature music to make 'Rainforest Music' using percussion instruments.
