Come and See

In Come and See we will be looking at the Eucharist as a memorial sacrifice in the Jewish sense of remembering, that is it makes present a past reality. It is a memorial of Christ's sacrifice on the Cross, through which Christ gives his body and blood for the salvation of all people and provides hope for the future.

After that we will begin our Topic on Lent. Lent is the season when Christians try to focus on giving. This helps us to identify with the complete sacrifice of Jesus which is remembered in the liturgy of Holy Week, especially the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday – Easter Sunday.)



English



This term we will be looking at our book "Cosmic" by Frank Cottrell-Boyce. Using this wonderful story we will write about feelings and perspectives, describe some of the amazing places featured in the book, and write a cliff hanger story.



In our reading lessons, we will be using 'Cosmic' to infer how different characters are thinking and feeling at different points and how they change over time. We will also be making predictions about what might happen and why we think it.



In spelling, punctuation and grammar, we will be looking at some more advanced punctuation such as colons as well as recapping our work on parentheses, apostrophes, and speech punctuation. We will be continuing our work on word families and suffixes that change meaning such as –ify, -ate and –ise to make verbs.















In Singapore Maths, we will be looking at fractions. We will focus on developing our ability to handle more diverse problems involving fractions, including dividing and multiplying fractions by whole numbers. We will show improper fractions and mixed numbers using pictures and find equivalent fractions by comparing and ordering. We will then look at adding and subtracting fractions, with similar denominators. Towards the end of the term, we will multiply mixed numbers and improper fractions by whole numbers.



Computing

This half term we will continue to improve our e-safety awareness by focussing on self-image and identity. We will continue to develop our understanding of managing an event in digital literacy



Science

Our topic focus this year will be on Space. We will be looking at how the Earth and its neighbours move through space and how we see (and count) this on Earth. We will also be learning about forces like gravity and how it keeps the solar system together. As well as the planets, we will be looking at famous astronauts and finding out about their lives and missions.































We will look at what's so special about the USA. Our focus will be on the location, physical and human characteristics of states and major cities.

Creative Arts

We will design a parachute to keep an egg safe and will continue to work on rhythm and singing using Charanga.

PSHE

In our PSHE week, we will be looking equality and diversity. We will be looking at how different people have different qualities in friendships and how a diverse society helps us experience other cultures.



P.E

We will be continuing swimming. We will also be looking at some wall, net games in Tennis.
