Come and Join the Celebration

In the topic 'Come and Join the Celebration' children will enjoy a range of activities which will link to different areas of learning including Art and Design, Dance and Drama. Children will learn 'What is a celebration?' and learn about different celebrations including a birthday, wedding and christening. Children will also learn about the Christmas story. At the end of the topic children will have the opportunity to be creative and create their own nativity scene using modelling clay.

Food, Glorious Food

In this topic we will be talking about their favourite food and learning about different types of food including crunchy food, sweet food and savoury food. Children will learn about growing food such as fruit and vegetables whilst also having fun creating their own healthy smoothie using fresh fruit. At the end of this topic children will enjoy holding their own class food festival and have a celebration of food.

Ticket to Ride

In the unit 'Ticket to Ride' children will learn about different types of transport including trains, buses, aeroplanes, boats and much more. They will be ordering the transport from the slowest to the quickest and be designing their own transport tickets. We will also be thinking about different destinations and what countries we could travel to and what transport we could take to get there. Towards the end of the topic children will be thinking about holidays and what they might pack in their suitcase to take on holiday.

If You Go Down to the Woods

In the final enrichment unit 'if You Go
Down to the Woods' children will learn
about materials including wood. Children
will have fun going on a wood hunt
around school to look for items that are
made out of wood. We will then explore
trees and plants and enjoy singing a song
about different types of trees. As a class
we will plant a sunflower seed and watch
it grow and change over time when
learning about growing things and caring
for living things. Children will also be
looking at and researching different
woodland creatures that live in the woods.
