Reflection

One of the topics of conversation in our country is 'the weather'. The daytime temperature has risen to the dizzy heights of 32 centigrade in recent days and parts of the British Isles have had record temperatures for this month. Our families, neighbours, and the media offer advice on how to cope with this extreme heat, while some seem to take it in their stride. Meanwhile, some countries in Europe have had torrential rain which has resulted in the destruction of human life and homes, places of work and leisure, and left many bereft of family, friends, and neighbours.

The pandemic has taught many of us to appreciate the gift of human life and brought us closer to many we may have passed by when life was 'normal'. Those who have experienced great trauma in their life usually become more sensitive to the needs of others. Their priorities have changed, and they accept that life will never be quite the same.

In the 10 months I have been in Widnes I have heard people recalling events in their life that have been extremely challenging. Somehow, they have kept going and I believe that they are a wonderful witness to the grace of God working with the clay of our human life, transforming them into something wholesome and beautiful. If we are faced with a fresh challenge in our life, it could also be key to a new and more wholesome way of life.
